## What is the Ladies Guild?

The Ladies Guild is affiliated with the Lutheran Women's Missionary League. Made up of the women of the church, they excel in special projects, fundraising, and fellowship among women.

## When does it meet?

- ◆ Once a month on the second Thursday of the month at 7:30 p.m.

## Where does it meet?

- ◆ Each month, the group meets in the church basement social hall. (December and August have typically been held at an outside location.)

## Who leads the group?

- ◆ The Ladies Guild is led by a president elected annually from the group membership. They have a vice-president, treasurer, and secretary also elected annually.

## How long is the term of office for the elected officials?

- ◆ The term of office for the various positions is for one year each.

## How do I get involved?

- ◆ Ask any of the Ladies Guild members.
- ◆ Attend a Ladies Guild meeting and see if you like it.
- ◆ Assist with one of the other Ladies Guild sponsored events.

## What is the mission of the Ladies Guild?

- ◆ The Mission of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League is to assist each woman of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod in affirming her relationship with the Triune God so that she is enabled to use her gifts in ministry to the people of the world

## What is the pledge of the Ladies Guild?

- ◆ In fervent gratitude for the Savior's dying love and His blood bought gift of redemption, we dedicate ourselves to Him with all that we are and have; and in obedience to His call for workers in the harvest fields, we pledge Him our willing service; wherever He hath need of us. We consecrate to our Savior our hands to work for Him, our feet to go on His errands, our voices to sing His praises, our lips to proclaim His redeeming love, our silver and our gold to extend His kingdom, our will to do His will, and every power of our life to the great tasks of bringing the lost and erring into eternal fellowship with Him..

- ◆ Attend Church regularly.
- ◆ Partake in the Sacraments often.
- ◆ Search the Scriptures.
- ◆ Contribute to her church regularly and liberally.
- ◆ Take an active part in the congregational life.
- ◆ Attend Ladies Guild meetings.
- ◆ Contribute through her Mite Box regularly.
- ◆ Take an active part in the Guild.

- ◆ Work and pray for the projects of the Guild.
- ◆ Be a real missionary.

- ◆ Contribute needed items for Lutheran World Relief
- ◆ Save designated labels for Bethesda
- ◆ Remember shut-ins with cards and visits
- ◆ Volunteers at the Manor Bi-weekly
- ◆ Volunteers for the Plattsmouth Nutrition Center
- ◆ And perhaps most importantly, renders ministry to the Word at the altar as the Altar Guild: services the candles, places the paraments, prepares the Holy Communion elements, etc. (See "What is the Altar Guild?")
